## Message from Inspector Mark Cant

A total of 25 vehicles being used illegally or involved in crime have been seized by police and are now off the road this month.

Person arrested for theft of caravan.

## Crime Updates (October to November 2018)

Offence	Numbers	What could this entail
Arson	0	Damage caused as a result of fire.
Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)	2	Harassment, alarm or distress is caused in a non-crime incident.
Burglary business and community	0	A person commits theft in a building or structure that is not lived in.
Burglary residential	3	Entry and theft in a building or a structure that is lived in.
Criminal Damage	11	A person destroys or damages property belonging to someone else.
Domestic	9	Domestic incidents where a crime has not occurred. Parties are aged 16 or over and have been intimate partners or family members regardless of sexuality.
Hate Incident	0	Any incident where a crime has not occurred which the victim, or anyone else, thinks is based on someone's prejudice towards them because of their race, religion, sexual orientation, disability or because they are transgender.
Race or Religious aggravated public fear	0	Any crime determined to have a hate element as per above.
Possession of controlled substance	5	Unlawful possession of a drug classified in class A, B or C.
Possession of weapons	1	Unlawful possession of an article used as a weapon.
Public fear, alarm or distress	6	Public order offences e.g. from a verbal altercation to offences just short of violence.
Robbery	0	Includes a range of offences where force is used, threatened or the victim is put in fear.
Theft from a motor vehicle	5	Any item stolen that was in, on or attached to a motor vehicle.
Theft or unauthorised taking of a motor vehicle	0	Any motor vehicle including those abandoned.
Theft of pedal cycle	0	From a public place, if stolen from a shed or garage this would be a BOTD.
Theft from a person	0	Purse being taken from a handbag, or a mobile phone from a shopping basket.



## Message from your Engagement Officer

As the Community Engagement Officer for West Norfolk I am keen that I spend as much time as possible engaging with community or supporting the local Beat Managers with their engagements. Currently we run SNAP (Safer Neighbourhood Action Partnerships) meetings across the area at Hunstanton, King's Lynn and Downham Market and the next meetings are on the 13th February, 6th February and 20th February respectively. I also hold a weekly surgery at King's Lynn Library on either a Thursday or Friday afternoon and I am looking at expanding these to other areas across the District.

In 2019 I will be supporting members of our Special Constabulary by holding recruitment events around the District looking at explaining the role of a Special Constable and the training they go through. Do keep an eye out for one of these events as they travel around the area.

## What is happening in your area

The safety camera van will be out and about on area responding to your calls to address speeding issues.

We are looking to hold an number of property marking days if any Parish is interested please contact myself.

### Neighbourhood Priorities

The Priority patrol area remains the A1122 and A47 in order to target transient criminals who enter the county via these routes.

We are also concentrating on rural crime and anti-social behaviour in Downham Market town centre.
